



## Homework 18-06-21

### Reading

The children should be reading at least 4 times a week, either practicing their words and sounds that have been sent home OR reading their books OR both!! Encourage them to sound out and blend words or recognise tricky words by sight. Talk about the books and ask them questions about what they are reading e.g. Who? Where? When? Why? About the text and pictures. Remember the reading reward for the next 6 weeks is a different prize each week (details of which have already been sent out).

### Literacy

This week we have been reading and writing about the 'Colour Monster'. We have used this story to explore our feelings - when the monster is black, he is worried, when he is red, he is angry, when he is green, he is calm, when he is yellow, he is happy and blue means he is sad. Talk about your feelings with your child and what puts you in the different colour moods.

Encourage your child to complete the attached sheets on two different days this week to show how they are feeling and why.

(I am feeling blue and sad because it is raining. I am feeling yellow and happy because the football is on.)

### Maths

We have been looking at 3D shapes this week and exploring their properties. Complete the attached 3D shape properties tables saying how many edges- sides, vertices - corners each shape has.
